NFL odds Use this tool to find the best odds for upcoming NFL games from the best sportsbooks in your region.

• The best odds available for each side of each game are highlighted in green

• Click on the sportsbook name to go directly to that betting site Getting started Start by selecting your odds format - the default is set to American odds, but decimal and fractional are also available.

Opening lines The opening line is the first set of odds released by the sportsbook and can be found in the 'Open' column towards the left of the screen

Consensus The consensus column on the right side of the screen shows you the total percentage of bettors in the Covers community who are backing each team without taking line movement into account.

Odds makers will set an estimated point total for a game, and you can bet whether the final score will add up to more (Over) or less (Under) points than that total.

All of the upcoming NFL Over/Under totals can be seen by choosing 'total' from the drop-down above the odds.

If you're looking to bet on NFL games for the first time this season, here's a simple guide to kicking off your football betting.

The first step in betting on NFL football is how to understand NFL betting lines

Both sides of the point spread will have another set of odds attached, known as the vig or juice.

Using Covers' parlay calculator, you can see how much you could win by combining different bets.

That team could go on a run in the season, moving their odds to +800 and then make the playoffs, adjusting their odds to +300.

Bettors can wager on the live spread, live Over/Under, or several other in-game markets, such as the result of the following series, or player to score the next touchdown.

The level of parity is also closer in the NFL than college football, which means

spreads are much smaller than those sometimes seen when betting on NCAA football.
